

BUILD YOUR OWN EDISON PHONOGRAPH!

PRINT ALL THREE PAGES. THE BASE AND THE BODY CAN BE PRINTED ON CARD STOCK. IT'LL HOLD UP BETTER. BEST REGULAR PAPER FOR THE HORN & ROLL.

CUT OUT ALL THE PIECES. I'VE LABELED THEM TO HELP KEEP TRACK. YOU CAN COLOR THEM IF YOU LIKE. (IT'S TOO HARD TO COLOR ONCE IT'S PUT TOGETHER.) PHONOGRAPH ROLLS WERE BLUE OR BLACK. THE BODY AND BASE WERE MADE OF DARK WOOD. PHONOGRAPH HORN WAS BLACK WITH A BRONZE RIM, INSIDE & OUT.

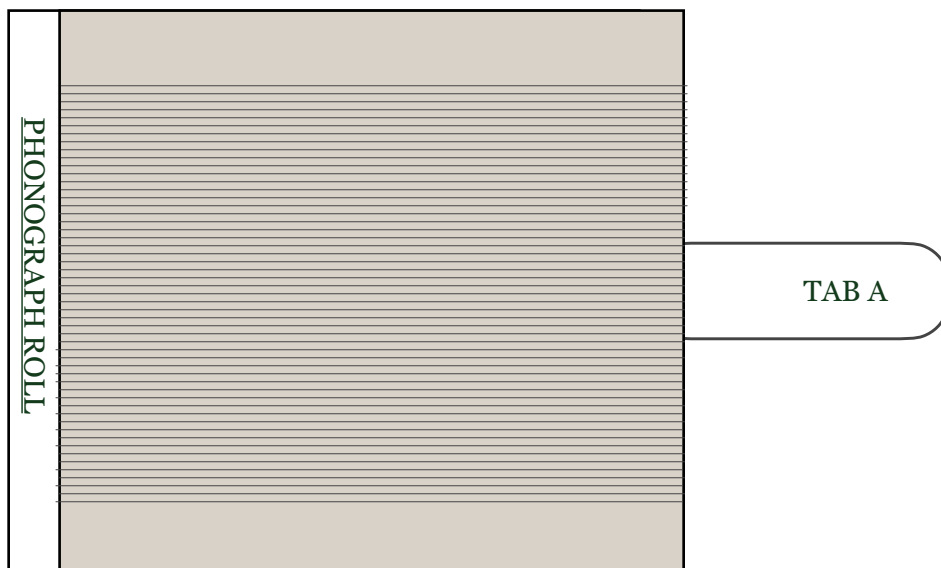
CUT OUT ALL THE SLOTS. (YOU MIGHT NEED HELP WITH THIS.) ROLL THE ROLL INTO A CYLINDER AND TAPE OR GLUE WHITE STRIP TO KEEP ITS SHAPE. ROLL THE HORN INTO A CONE USING TABS AND/OR TAPE. ASSEMBLE THE BODY BY INSERTING TABS INTO PROPER SLOTS. THEN MOUNT IT TO THE BASE.

INSERT THE ROLL AND HORN THROUGH THEIR SLOTS ON TOP OF BODY.

THE HOLE IN THE SIDE WAS WHERE THE CRANK WAS INSERTED. AND CRANK WAS STORED IN THE BODY. BUT YOU CAN MAKE YOUR OWN!

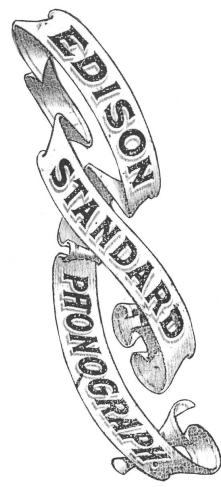
